Description	<p>In compiling the <code>micro_life_manager.cpp</code> file under Visual Studio 2008 the compile fails with two errors on lines which read <code>fromString(args[0], DisplayMicroLifeZones);</code></p> <p>These lines are around 887 and 900 in the file.</p> <p>The problem appears to be that in the previous version the line</p> <pre>#include <utility></pre> <p>Which was around line 45 has been removed. I suspect that <code>utility</code> contains the <code>fromString()</code> function and without it, the file cannot compile.</p> <p>I believe restoring the include file will fix the client build.</p>

Adding `#include <utility>` did not fix problem. (I tested it.) However, vl's fix of adding `nlmisc` namespace does correct the issue in both debug and release versions. Not sure how you mark things done with this software, but I'd say this one is fixed. Nice job vl.
