<p>When I try to exchange with an other player, my client crash with an out of memory error every time I click on a square to open the item selection box.</p> <p>Way to reproduce the crash:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">- ask an other player for a exchange- in the exchange window click on a square to choose the item to give- the client crash instantly with an out of memory error <p>The client has been built from source (2011-04-12) on a Slackware64.</p> <p>Output of the client attached</p>
