<b>Description</b>	<p>stdopenal.h seems to lack the &lt;AL/alex.h&gt; include on my system, which is why the compilation fails with a missing macro reference in sound_driver_al.cpp. I have no idea if adding #include &lt;AL/alex.h&gt; after the other two OpenAL header files (<i>must be after</i> these two!) will "fix" it on every other system (is there an AL/alex.h with every OpenAL distribution?).</p>
